

Improving Last Mile Health Coverage Through Strengthening eSanjeevani National Telemedicine Services



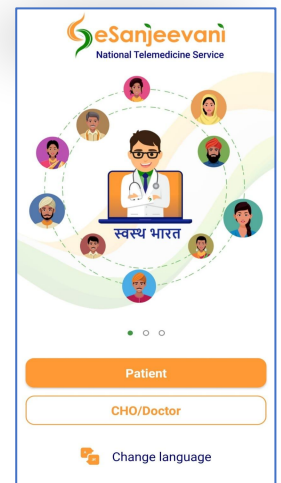
The Problem:

- Access to Healthcare is challenge in rural and remote areas
- Women in India face greater health access barriers than men –
- Women spend 1.5 times more on healthcare and are 2 times less likely to access health care services
- Health at last mile is a national high priority.
- Resource constrained states need support for implementing digital innovations like telemedicine to address these problems.



The Solution: eSanjeevani

- eSanjeevani – National Telemedicine Service of India is a step towards digital health equity to achieve Universal Health Coverage (UHC).
- eSanjeevani facilitates quick and easy access to doctors and medical specialists from your mobile (eSanjeevani OPD)
- One can also access quality health services remotely via eSanjeevani by visiting the nearest Ayushman Bharat Health & Wellness Centre (eSanjeevani AB-HWC)



However, states face challenges in the effective deployment of eSanjeevani – poor adoption, poor quality of care, lack of standard operating procedures.

We support states to effectively and efficiently deploy eSanjeevani to improve health access and health outcomes for vulnerable populations.

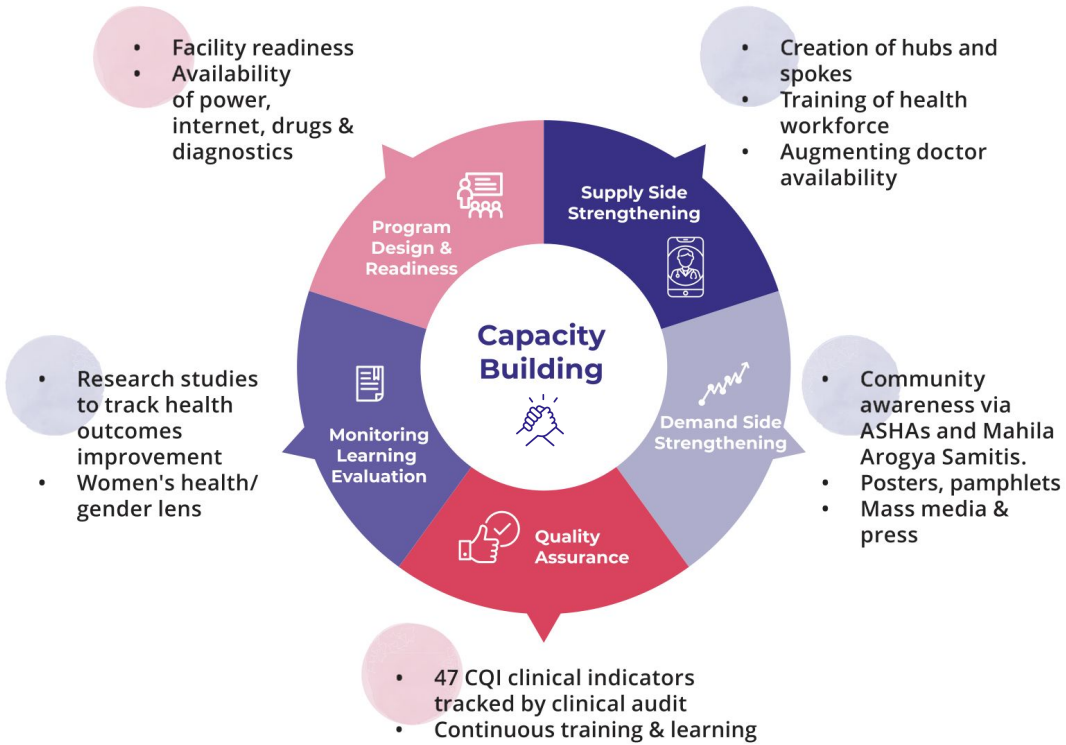
